<i>Alabama</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel is allowed sunset 7/2 until sunrise 7/6.
<i>Alberta</i>	Open	Open	No travel after 3:00pm 6/30 and all day 7/1 if over 12'7" wide.
<i>Arizona</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/2 until 1/2 before sunrise 7/6 if over 10' wide, 14'6" high, 10' long front overhang, 10' long rear overhang, 120' long, or 250,000 lbs. Travel allowed at 3am 7/6 if night movement transport is allowed.
<i>Arkansas</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel sunset 7/3 until sunrise 7/6. Overweight only loads may travel.
<i>British Columbia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Open	No travel 3:30pm 6/30 until 12:01am 7/2
<i>California</i>	Open	Open	If pilot required, no travel 7/2 4:00pm-midnight. No travel 7/3, 7/4, and 7/5 from noon - midnight.
<i>Colorado</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 7/3 & 7/4 between 12:00 pm and 9:00 pm.
<i>Connecticut</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 7/4.
<i>Delaware</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/3 until 9:00am 7/5.
<i>Florida</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 7/3 or 7/4 if over 10' wide, 14' 6" high or 80 long.
<i>Georgia</i>	Open	Open	No Super Loads or Annuals Issued. No travel 7/4.
<i>Idaho</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	Black-Coded Routes and Interstate Routes- No travel 4:00pm 7/3 until dawn 7/5 if over 12'W, 15', or 120' L. Red Coded Routes - No travel 2:00pm 7/3 until dawn 7/6
<i>Illinois</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel from noon 7/3 until sunrise 7/5.
<i>Indiana</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/3 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 7/6. Overweight and bulk milk commodity permits exempt from travel restrictions.
<i>Iowa</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/3 until 30 minutes before sunrise 7/6.
<i>Kansas</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel restrictions.
<i>Kentucky</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel restrictions unless noted on the permit. Only super loads and house move could be limited.
<i>Louisiana</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel restrictions
<i>Maine</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 7/4 or 7/5. In July and August, moves are also prohibited Saturday and Sunday except for equipment moving within the seven northern counties.
<i>Manitoba</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Open	Vehicles exceeding 3.7 m in width or 31 m in length are not allowed to travel on holiday 7/1 or from 3:00pm to midnight 6/30 - PTH 1: Falcon Lake to MB/ON border, PTH 6: All, PTH 8: All, PTH 9: All, PTH 10: U.S. border to Riding Mountain National Park, PTH 11: North of Hwy 44, PTH 12: North of Hwy 15, PTH 15: All, PTH 16: All, PTH 44: All, PTH 59: North of the West Boundary of Brokenhead Ojibway Nation reserve, PTH 59: PTH 100 south to St. Malo, PR 214: All, PR 307: All, PR 313: All, PR 317: All.
<i>Maryland</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/2 until 9:00 am 7/6. Containerized Cargo- No travel 9:00pm 7/2 until 4:00am 7/6.
<i>Massachusetts</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/3 until noon 7/5.
<i>Michigan</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/3 until daylight 7/6. Mobile homes noon 7/6.
<i>Minnesota</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel after 2:00pm 7/2 until 2:00am 7/5 if over 12'6" wide or 110' long. (Summer weekends -5/30-8/25 - Travel is restricted from 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. on Fridays and Sundays. Holiday and summer weekend is only restricted if exceeding 12'6" wide and/or 110' long. Overweight only not restricted unless noted on the permit
<i>Mississippi</i>	Open	Open	Closed 7/6. No travel from noon 7/3 until sunrise 7/7. Loads qualifying for 24/7 movement- no restrictions.
<i>Missouri</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 7/2 until 30 minutes before sunrise 7/6.
<i>Montana</i>	Open	<b>Closed</b>	Interstate - Travel on interstate highways is allowed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, up to 18' wide, including essential services within one-half mile of the interstate highway. Loads exceeding 18' wide cannot travel on 7/4. Non-Interstate - Travel on non-interstate highways is allowed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for loads up to 10' wide and/or 15'6" high. Loads exceeding 10'wide and/or 15'6" high, up to 12'6"wide and/or 15'6" high may travel during daylight hours only. Loads exceeding 12'6' wide and/or 15'6" high

New York	Open	Open	No travel from noon 7/3 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 7/6.
North Carolina	Open	Closed	No travel for overwidth, overheight or overlength permitted vehicle/vehicle combinations or vehicle combinations with a gross weight exceeding 112,000 lbs. from noon 7/3 until noon 7/6. Continuous travel for overweight only loads not exceeding 112,000 lbs.
North Dakota	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/3 until sunrise 7/6 if over 16'W.
Nova Scotia	Closed	Open	No travel after 3:00pm 6/29 & after noon 6/30 & 7/1.
Ohio	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/2 until sunrise 7/6. No travel restrictions for overweight only loads.
Ohio Turnpike	Open	Open	No travel sunrise 7/3 until sunrise 7/5 if over 13'6"high, or 90' long.
Oklahoma	Open	Closed	No travel 7/4.
Ontario	Closed	Open	Travel allowed from sunrise to noon 7/1 if dimensions do not exceed 3.70 m wide on two lane highways and 3.85 m on multi-lane highways, 12.5 m long for single vehicles or 25 m for combination vehicles, 4.26 m high, or greater than 63,500 kg. If over these dimensions, no travel 7/1.
Oregon	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/3 until 1/2 before sunrise 7/6.
Pennsylvania	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/2 until sunrise 7/6.
Pennsylvania Turnpike	Open	Open	No travel 5:00am 6/26 until 11:00pm 7/5.
Quebec	Closed	Open	No travel 7/1.
Rhode Island	Open	Open	State Closed Monday 7/06. No travel noon 7/3 until sunrise 7/6
Saskatchewan	Closed	Open	No travel after 3:00pm 6/30 and after noon 7/1 if over 85 m maximum width, 42 m, or 9m rear overhang.
South Carolina	Open	Closed	No travel 7/4.
South Dakota	Open	Closed	No travel restrictions.
Tennessee	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/2 through 7/4 if pilot required for oversize/overweight loads. No travel 7/4 for Site Built houses, and House boats.
Texas	Open	Open	No travel for manufactured housing 7/4 unless exception granted.
Utah	Open	Closed	No travel 2:00pm 7/3 until sunrise 7/6 if over 14' H, 10' W and 105' overall length.
Vermont	Open	Closed	No travel 7/3 or weekend if over 12' wide, 100' long or 108,000 lbs.
Virginia	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/3 until 7/6 .
Washington	Open	Closed	No travel noon 7/3 until daylight 7/5. Mobile homes noon 7/5.
West Virginia	Open	Closed	No travel 7/4.
Wisconsin	Open	Open	No travel noon 7/3 until sunrise 7/5 if over 12' wide, 13'6 high, or 150' long for vehicles traveling statewide counties including the Milwaukee County Expressway. If less than these dimensions (smaller vehicles), no travel 4:00- 8:00pm 7/3, 7/4 or 7/5 - smaller vehicles cannot travel in the following counties: Columbia, Dane, Milwaukee, Rock and Waukesha to also include the Milwaukee Expressway. Overweight only may travel 24/7 unless specified on the permit.
Wyoming	Open	Closed	No travel 1/2 after sunrise 7/3 until 1/2 hour after sunset 7/6.
