<i>State</i>	<b>9/1</b>	<b>Restrictions</b>
<i>Alabama</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel sunset 8/30 until sunrise 9/2
<i>Alberta</i>	<b>Open</b>	No travel 3:00pm until midnight on a Friday, all day Sunday, or all day on the holiday if over 3.85 m wide
<i>Arizona</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel after noon 8/29 until one-half hour before sunrise 9/2 if over 10' wide, (11'wide if crane, drill rig or other specialty equipment) 14'6" high, 120' long, 10' front overhang, 10' rear overhang, or 250,000 lbs. If night transport is permitted, travel may resume at 3am Tuesday 9/2
<i>Arkansas</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel sunset 8/29 until sunrise 9/2
<i>British Columbia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 8/31 or 9/1
<i>California</i>	<b>Closed</b>	If load does not require a pilot car or CHP Escort no restrictions. If escort is required travel times are prohibited from 4:00p.m. to 12:00a.m. on 8/29, and 12:00p.m. to 12:00a.m. 8/30, 8/31, and 9/1.
<i>Colorado</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon-9:00pm 8/29 or 6:00am-9:00pm 9/1. If weight is less than 100,000 and legal dimensions no restrictions
<i>Connecticut</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until daylight 9/2
<i>Delaware</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/31 until 9:00 am 9/2
<i>Florida</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1 if over 10' wide, 14' 6" high or 80' long
<i>Georgia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>Idaho</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Red coded routes-No travel after 2:00 p.m. on 8/29 until dawn 9/2. Black coded routes- No travel if over 12' W, 15' H, or 120' L from 4:00pm 8/29 until sunrise 9/2
<i>Illinois</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/31 until sunrise 9/2. Travel Restrictions apply to all over-dimension loads, except implements of husbandry that are only over-width.
<i>Indiana</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel from noon 8/29 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 9/2. Overweight Commodity Permits are exempt from holiday travel restrictions which apply to vehicles hauling metal commodities up to 120,000 lbs. or agricultural commodities up to 97,000 lbs.
<i>Iowa</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel from noon 8/29 until 30 minutes before sunrise 9/2
<i>Kansas</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No Travel Restrictions
<i>Kentucky</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel restrictions unless noted on the permit. Only super loads and house move could be limited.
<i>Louisiana</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No Travel Restrictions
<i>Maine</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>Manitoba</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 4:00pm 8/29 until 9/2 if vehicles exceeds 3.7 m in width or 31 m in length on the following routes: PTH 1: Falcon Lake to MB/ON border, PTH 6: All, PTH 8: All, PTH 9: All, PTH 10: U.S. border to Riding Mountain National Park, PTH 11: North of Hwy 44, PTH 12: North of Hwy 15, PTH 15: All, PTH 16: All, PTH 44: All, PTH 59: North of the West Boundary of Brokenhead Ojibway Nation reserve, PTH 59: PTH 100 south to St. Malo, PR 214: All, PR 307: All, PR 313: All, PR 317: All
<i>Maryland</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 9:00am 9/2. Containerized cargo - No travel from 9:00pm 8/29 through 4:00am 9/2
<i>Massachusetts</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>Michigan</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2. Mobile homes may resume travel at noon 9/2
<i>Minnesota</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 2:00pm 8/31 until 2:00am 9/2 if over 12'6 wide or 110' long. Overweight only may travel unless noted on the permit.
<i>Mississippi</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel after noon 8/30 until sunrise 9/2 unless permit shows 24 hour travel. Sealed Container exempt.
<i>Missouri</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 30 minutes before sunrise 9/2

<i>Montana</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Interstate - Travel on interstate highways is allowed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week, up to 18' wide, including essential services within one-half mile of the interstate highway. Loads exceeding 18' wide cannot travel on 9/1. NonInterstate - Travel on non-interstate highways is allowed 24 hours per day, 7 days per week for loads up to 10' wide and/or 15'6" high. Loads exceeding 10' wide and/or 15'6" high, up to 12'6" wide and/or 15'6" high may travel during daylight hours only. Loads exceeding 12'6" wide and/or 15'6" high cannot travel 9/14
<i>Nebraska</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2. Overweight only may travel 24/7.
<i>Nevada</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon until midnight 8/29 & 9/1 if over 12' wide, 15' high, 110' long or over 15' overhang.
<i>New Brunswick</i>	<b>Closed</b>	If over 12 wide and up to 98'6" long must be off road by 3pm on Friday and start again on Saturday, Sunday and holiday Monday from sunrise until noon. If over 98'6" long cannot travel on weekend or holiday.
<i>New Hampshire</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>New Jersey</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 8/29 or 9/1
<i>New Mexico</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 30 minutes after sunset 8/31 until 30 minutes before sunrise 9/2. Loads that are overweight only or granted continuous movement may travel 8/31 until 11:59pm MST.
<i>New York</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 9/2
<i>New York Thruway</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 9/2
<i>North Carolina</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Travel is authorized by prior issued permit.
<i>North Dakota</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/30 until sunrise 9/2 if over 16' wide.
<i>Nova Scotia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel after 3:00 pm 8/29 and after noon on 8/30, 8/31, and 9/1 if over 12' wide or 98'4" long
<i>Ohio</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2. Overweight only vehicles may travel with a permit.
<i>Ohio Turnpike</i>	<b>Open</b>	No travel sunrise 8/29 until sunrise 9/2 if over 13'6" high or 90' long
<i>Oklahoma</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1.
<i>Ontario</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 9/2 if over 12'2" wide two lane highways, 12'8" wide on multilane highways, 82' long for combination vehicles, 14' high, or 139,000 lbs.
<i>Oregon</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until 1/2 hour before sunrise 9/2.
<i>Pennsylvania</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2
<i>Pennsylvania Turnpike</i>	<b>Open</b>	No travel 3:00pm 8/28 until 11:00pm 9/1
<i>Quebec</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1.
<i>Rhode Island</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel sunset 8/29 until sunrise 9/2 if over 8'6" wide, 80' L, or 130,000 lbs.
<i>Saskatchewan</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel after 3:00pm 8/29 and after noon 8/31 or 9/1 if over 3.85 m wide, 42 m long or rear overhang over 9 m
<i>South Carolina</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>South Dakota</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No Travel Restrictions
<i>Tennessee</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon Friday, 8/29 until 9/2 if load requires escort. No travel 9/1 for site-built houses and house boats.
<i>Texas</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1 for manufactured housing.
<i>Utah</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 2:00 pm to midnight 8/29 and no travel 9/1 if over 10' wide, 105' long, 14'6" high, or front or rear overhang over 10'.

<i>Vermont</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 8/30 through 9/1 if 12' wide, 100' long and/or 108,000 lbs. and over.
<i>Virginia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2
<i>Washington</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/31 until 9/2
<i>West Virginia</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel 9/1
<i>Wisconsin</i>	<b>Closed</b>	No travel noon 8/29 until sunrise 9/2 if over 12' wide, 13'6 h, or 150' long. If less than these dimensions (smaller vehicles), no travel 8/29, 8/30, 8/31, or 9/1 from 4:00pm - 8:00pm. - smaller vehicles cannot travel in the following counties: Columbia, Dane, Milwaukee, Rock and Waukesha to also include the Milwaukee Expressway. Vehicles overweight only, unless specified on the permit, may travel 24/7.
<i>Wyoming</i>	<b>Closed</b>	Loads requiring escorts will not be allowed to travel from ½ hour after sunset 8/30 to ½ hour before sunrise 9/3. Ports of Entry are closed. Must have a valid permit before entering the state.
